

506 CARNEGIE CENTER LOBBY

To align aesthetically with the lobbies of other buildings in the Carnegie Center office complex—part of a 2 million-square-foot campus owned by Boston Properties—JZA+D updated the two-story lobby and common corridors of this building to convey a more modern aesthetic.

The existing lobby had been characterized by exposed brick and dreary carpeting, dated finishes that no longer aligned with the Class A status of the building. To refresh the space, JZA+D specified cherry wood and gypsum board paneling for the walls. The cleaner lines of the updated wall finishes, in addition to the new stone tile floor, convey a cleaner, more streamlined, professional aesthetic.

New, sculptural lighting fixtures have been added throughout to brighten the space and accentuate the expanse and breadth of the lobby, which is accessible from both the front and rear of the building.
