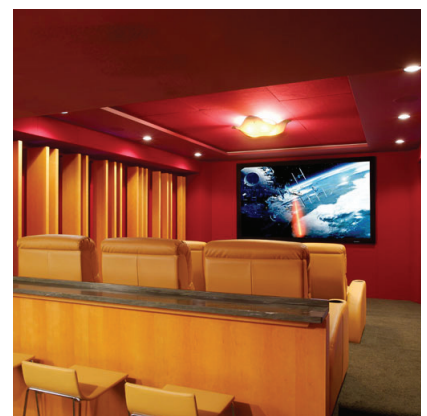

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Renovation and Interiors

JZA+D was tasked to transform and maximize 2,000 square feet of basement space into a multifaceted family entertainment haven. The design created various living spaces including a dynamic playroom, a workshop, a gym, a bathroom and a windowed wine room with a Limestone floor and a mix of floating metal and redwood wine racks. The highlight of the basement features a modern home theatre wrapped with claret-burgundy colored panels that surround movie-watchers with fins of hovering maple - both utilized for visual resonance and acoustical splendor.

Using "Re-Green" Standards and Interior Design Guidelines, incorporated into the finished space were no VOC paint; acrylic panels made from 100% recycled product and FSC certified wood products. The new theatre and wine cellar caused significant energy increase and therefore JZA+D specified the installation of new solar panels, as well as, assisting in the application process for tax rebates.
