

## SKY ON 57

**DATE:** January 2011

**LOCATION:** Marina Bay, Singapore

**SIZE:** 13,000 SF

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Architecture and Interior Design

The 57th level of the Marina Bay Sands resort and casino comprises a grand Skypark with pools, sitting areas, observation decks and dining areas. JZA+D provided complete architecture and design services for this 300 seat restaurant, bar, and lounge.

Located on the southern end of the park and with expansive views of Singapore, Malaysia and the Pacific ocean, the dynamic and open floor plan is a modern space that is understated yet full of simulating visual features. JZA+D created a sleek setting that is accentuated by glass panels with embedded photographic images; floating ceiling panels with several dropped chandeliers framed by a drop ceiling cutout that is up-lit; recessed and lit soffits create visual movement through the space; and flowing fins wrap around the kitchen, and open up to expose a 2,000 bottle wine storage. This transitions the back-of-house elements into a “special feature”. JZA+D transformed the 3,000 SF outdoor terrace, which wraps around the restaurant, into a stylish seating area where guests can enjoy Sky on 57’s cuisine while experiencing amazing ocean and city views, from dawn to dusk.

In addition to space planning, programming, schematic design, construction documents and coordination, and partial construction administration, the project included complete interior design services. JZA+D also designed all furniture pieces, some light fixtures and prepared furniture, fixture, and equipment packages.
